




# NON-CHARGEABLE WORK ORDERS for repairs to original structure

- Siding Repair (original)
- Roof Repair
- Gutter Repair (original)
- Shutter Repair (original)
- Mailbox Repair or Replacement
- Paper chute Repair or Replacement (on mailbox)
- Garbage Can Repair or Replacement (not responsible for damage to concrete when garbage can is encased).
- Tree Branches or Limbs that are posing a hazard to siding or roof.
- De-Winterization
- 1. A Master Insurance Policy that covers rebuilding of a home to builders' grade in the event of a catastrophic loss. It is strongly recommended that owners purchase an HO6 insurance policy to cover the contents of the residence, liability and any additions or upgrades to the original structure e.g., replacements windows, doors, siding, etc.
- 2. Bus Service
- 3. Grass Cutting
- 4. Snow will be plowed from roads and driveways when the accumulations exceed 3 inches. Sidewalks will be shoveled for Units without a driveway.
- 5. Mailbox Repairs and Replacements
- 6. Trimming of Trees that affect roof or siding
- 7. Road Potholes and Maintenance of Street Signs
- 8. Yearly Termite Inspections of Crawl Spaces
- 9. Gutter Cleanings (1 in Spring and 1 in Fall)
- 10. Gutter Repair (not Replace) to original gutters
- 11. Once yearly dryer vent cleaning




