

HOME IGNITION ZONE CHECKLIST

Simple steps from roof to foundation to make a home safer from embers and radiant heat.

- Clean roofs and gutters of dead leaves, debris and pine needles that could catch embers.
- Replace or repair any loose or missing shingles or roof tiles to prevent ember penetration.
- Reduce embers that could pass through vents П in the eaves by installing 1/8 inch metal mesh screening.
- □ Clean debris from exterior attic vents and install 1/8 inch metal mesh screening to reduce embers.
- □ Repair or replace damaged or loose window screens and any broken windows.
- Screen or box-in areas below patios and decks with wire mesh to prevent debris and combustible materials from accumulating.
- Move any flammable material away from wall exteriors - mulch, flammable plants, leaves and needles, firewood piles - anything that can burn
- □ Remove anything stored underneath decks or porches.

Snow Removal Guidelines

Below is a reminder of the procedures that all resident's in Crestwood Village V must adhere to during snow events.


- * Generally, snow removal will not begin until the snow has stopped falling.
- * Plowing will not start until snow accumulation has reached three (3) inches.
- * The main roads and finger streets will be plowed first.
- * Resident's that are on the medical plowing list (*for dialysis patient's only*) will have their driveways completed next.
- * Driveways will be plowed when main roads, finger streets and medical plowing is completed.
- * Any home without a garage will have their sidewalks shoveled. No other sidewalks will be shoveled by the contractor.
- * If your car is parked in your driveway at the time the plow comes along, your driveway will not be plowed. If you go out and move your car, the plows will not return.
- * If you have a paver driveway abutting your driveway, that portion will not be plowed.
- * The Resident is responsible for any snow remaining on the driveway after it has been plowed, this includes blowing or drifting snow.
- * Cars that are left on the street or finger street during a snowstorm may be towed, at the owner's expense, so that the streets can be adequately plowed.
- * Salting of roads will be based on conditions /temperature and at the discretion of the Trustees.

As with any other situation, if you have a medical emergency during a storm, do not call the Association office to be plowed out, please call 911.

PLEASE DO NOT CALL THE ANSWERING SERVICE AFTER HOURS BECAUSE YOU HAVE NOT BEEN PLOWED. THE ANSWERING SERVICE CANNOT PROVIDE ANY INFORMATION AND CANNOT DISPATCH THE PLOWS.

Issues/problems regarding the snow removal, as always should be in writing on a complaint form, available at the clubhouse. Complaints will not be taken over the telephone.

Recognizing that Crestwood Village V is not an assisted living facility, homeowner's have a responsibility to adequately prepare themselves and their homes in case of snow. Stocking up on food and emergency supplies is an extremely important safety step to take. Making sure that you are refilled on your prescription medication is also a vital step to take. When possible, rescheduling appointments is recommended. The Association Office sells ice melt and will deliver it to your door. The ice melt is \$8 for a 10 pound bag. Should you want a bag of ice melt delivered to you, kindly fill out a work order advising of how many bags of ice melt you would like and submit to the Association Office with your payment in cash or check. The Association's maintenance men will not lay the ice melt; that is the homeowner's responsibility. The Association's maintenance men will not shovel snow or clear paths due to melting or drifting snow (after the contractor does an initial clean up); this is a homeowner's responsibility. Although the Association recognizes that there are many elderly retired persons in the community who are no longer capable of these tasks, regrettably these tasks are beyond the Association's scope of services.

If you find yourself, or know of a neighbor, that needs our help just say so. There is no shame or embarrassment in asking for help. Just leave a private note with your (or your neighbor's) name, address, and phone number. Someone from the pantry will contact you.

At the same time, we ask our residents that can, to please donate to our pantry. We can rehome non-perishable food products, shelf stable milk, canned fruit, canned chicken, paper goods, pasta, etc.

You can simply drop these things by the food pantry door. We can also accept monetary donations and gift cards as we use them to buy things like eggs and bread, etc. Just leave them for the pantry at the office window.



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
